We teach and celebrate the Liturgy of the Word portion of the mass with the children. Prayers, reading of the week's lectionary selections, singing, and a lesson are all part of a typical CLOW session. Twice a year, a small craft is brought in for the children. From September through May at the 4:30, 8:00 and 10:00 masses Teens through adults may serve in this ministry.

All adults (ages 18+) are required to complete a background check as well as the Protecting God's Children program. High School Teens must complete a teen background check and must have a meeting with the CLOW coordinator and the teen's parents. Middle School volunteers must have a meeting with the CLOW coordinator and the teen's parents. There is also a short training session of about one hour. Training may also take place at an actual CLOW session.
