Come prayerfully celebrate the Memorial of St. Therese of Lisieux

St. Therese of Lisieux came to know the truth of the merciful love that God has for creation. She knew that merciful love from God was an invitation to allow the love of God to flow through her into the lives of others through small acts.

There are several labyrinths at St. Therese shrines across the US. The labyrinth is a metaphor for life's journey, which offers time for reflection as the path is walked. It also encourages meditation, prayer, and seeking the peace and serenity which only God provides. We begin in the outer and walk our way into our inner sacred center seeking God. We walk back to the outer world bringing our renewed self, focused on God.

A Chartres labyrinth will be available in the Gathering Place for you to take a spiritual journey into your interior and back out into the world. Spend a few minutes or longer in prayer.



### Welcome Danielle!







**DISPLAY:** The display features detailed panels highlighting some of the most powerful Eucharistic miracles of the world.

Each panel tells the story of a Eucharistic miracle and is accompanied by photos and artwork that have been recognized by their local bishops.

The display's purpose is to increase awareness of the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist and promote Eucharistic adoration.

**St. Carlo Acutis:** Only 15 years old when he died of leukemia in 2006. Carlo was canonized September 7, 2025. His age and interest in using digital communication to reach and teach others led to Acutis being popularly dubbed "The Patron Saint of the Internet" and "The First Millennial Saint" shortly after his beatification.






