



Seminarian Jack Meinhart

Jack Meinhart is currently in his first year of seminary formation. He was born August 4, 1999 and grew up in Glen Ellyn, Illinois. His home parish is Saint Petronille. Jack recently graduated from Bradley University with degrees in History and Philosophy along with a minor in Legal Studies.

When he was young, Jack was very attracted to the idea of becoming a priest. He loved reading the Bible, and had many good examples of priests in his life. He even was able to visit Mundelein on a Jeremiah Day event. Despite these initial calls, as he entered high school and college, Jack drifted from the faith. "I changed my life's goal to becoming a successful lawyer and spent my time in college

working towards this career," Jack said. "While on the outside I was doing well, only a few steps away from applying to law



It was through a long period of prayer, and learning more about our Catholic faith that I began to feel the call again; not just back to the church, but to becoming a priest. How great is God's mercy and love for each of us is!" Spending time in eucharistic adoration, beholding Jesus in the most holy sacrament, greatly helped Jack in growing

his relationship with God and further feeling the call to the priesthood.

Since then, he has had so many graces enter into his life. He is currently taking a "Spirituality Year", a stage in seminary formation that allows men like him to dive deeper into their Catholic faith. Jack has been given the opportunity to read the Bible and Catechism in a year, along with serving impoverished neighborhoods in the city of Chicago. He feels so blessed to have begun this journey to the priesthood.

He is currently at St. Paul Seminary in Pre-Theology 1. Please continue to pray for Jack and his discernment.

How to Support Your Priests

Parishioners can encourage the priesthood by praying daily for vocations and for priests, by encouraging men they know to consider the priesthood, and by actively supporting the church's vocation ministry. Encouraging a priestly vocation includes recognizing spiritual commitment, such as regular participation in prayer and spiritual events, and speaking to potential candidates to offer support and invite them to explore the possibility of a vocation. A supportive community that fosters openness to God's call is crucial for men and women to discern and respond to a vocation to the priesthood or religious life.


