ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER GIVING GUIDE

What are the major advantages of electronic giving?

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is all about convenience for you and consistency for the church.

Electronic giving eliminates frequent check writing and helps members stay on track with pledges even when they are unable to be at church. The church in turn benefits from much-needed donation consistency and a reduction in the volume of check and cash contributions that must be handled and manually processed.

How does EFT work?

Contributions are transferred automatically from your checking or savings account to the church's bank account.

How are my automatic contributions deducted and transferred?

After completing an Authorization Form, your contributions are transferred through the Automated Clearing House (ACH) network.

If I do not write checks, how do I balance my checkbook?

Since your contribution is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

Without a cancelled check, how can I prove I made my contribution?

Your bank statements give you an itemized list of electronic transfers. In addition, you can request a Charitable Contribution Tax Report for the year.

How much does EFT cost?

It costs you and the church nothing.

What if I try it and don't like it? Or what if I need to change the amount of the withdrawal, or when the withdrawal is occurring or bank accounts?

You can cancel your authorization at any time by notifying the church office. Amounts and bank information can easily be changed too! Just let the office know as soon as possible.

How can I sign up for electronic giving?

All you need is the EFT AUTHORIZATION FORM. Complete the form, sign and attach a voided check/savings deposit slip. Return it to the church by mail or in the offering basket.
